SMALL GROUPS - \$6 per dancer (maximum of \$30)

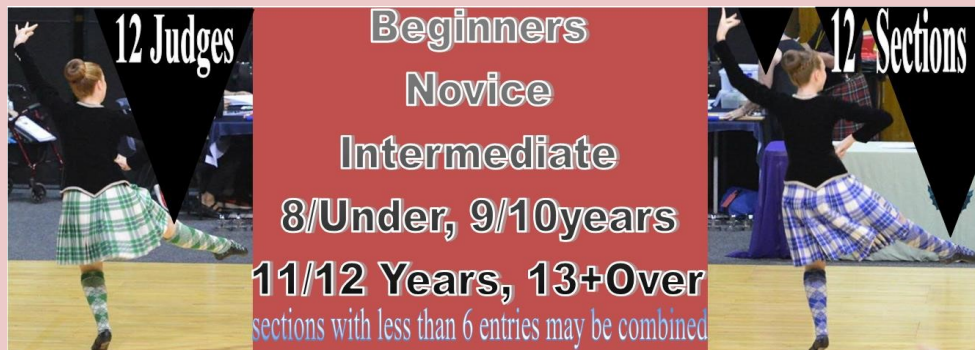
Minimum 3, maximum 6 competitors, max 4 minutes.

CHAMPIONS CHALLENGE

For dancers who have won a Championship in their career or placed top 3 in a Championship three times in the last two years.

PRE-CHAMPIONSHIP

For dancers who haven't won a Championship or Pre-Championship.

PREMIER AGGREGATE

For dancers who have won a Championship or Pre-Championship, but do not qualify for Champion's Challenge. Dancers who meet criteria for Champions Challenge can choose aggregate instead.
